COVID RESPONSE

Message from Quebec Public Health and la Table interreligieuse de concertation

A recent email from Public Health to la Table interreligieuse de concertation invites those responsible for places of worship to participate in awareness-raising efforts on the importance of wearing a mask in public places. This is not obligatory, but participation on our part can help to ensure that the number of people requiring hospital care remains reasonable, thus removing any possibility of restrictive health measures, as we have already experienced.

2023 Pulpit Supply Rates

Conseil régional Nakonha:ka Regional Council has mandated that LLWLs receive compensation for pulpit supply at the same rate described by the General Council for visiting ministry personnel. The rates for 2023 are set at \$232 daily, with a mileage allowance of \$0.55 per kilometre.

A proposal was recently put forward by the LLWL Leadership Team and approved by the Executive further to a question being raised regarding the possibility of becoming an LLWL if one had a criminal record (for a crime that more than likely would not qualify for a pardon.)

To mark the eve of Conference opening, GreenFaith Montréal organized a simple candlelight vigil in St James Square on Tuesday, Dec 6. The vigil was part of the conclusion of the Montreal City Mission interfaith/intercultural Good Neighbour dinner event, co-hosted by CBC Montreal.

Another initiative to highlight COP15 was The March for Biodiversity and Human Rights in Montreal on December 10, organized by the Quebec Civil Society Collective for COP15. Led by an Indigenous delegation, it brought together more than 80 organizations mobilizing for biodiversity protection in the context of COP15 along with local and international allies.




